Successful students are expected to enter into a bursary contract with Umgeni Water. The agreement contains all general provisions related to the Bursary Programme, which is primarily aimed at developing professional engineers and scientists.

- Proof of parent (s) or guardian income (salary payslip). In the case of deceased parent(s), attach copy of Death Certificates.
