- Applicants already receiving a bursary or financial aid will not be entertained ie NSFAS
- Admission to study or registered as a full-time student, pursuing formal degree studies.
- **Students studying towards obtaining a degree in any discipline (career & choice of study)** will be considered. However, good academic record is a prerequisite.
- Students must be from the Northern Cape Province
- EE: Preference will be only given to African and Coloured Males and Female applicants.

- Successful candidates shall be offered a stipend which will be determined by Management;
