### INFORMATION REGARDING BURSARY APPLICATIONS

### 1. CANDIDATES WHO ARE ELIGIBLE

- 1.1. South African Citizens with a valid ID number residing in the Republic of South Africa currently studying full time at Stellenbosch University and who have successfully completed their 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> year of studying at Stellenbosch University may apply for a bursary for their 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> year of studying at Stellenbosch University;
- 1.2. Students who are willing to do vacation work at Southern Farms (Northern Cape) or any affiliated farm during the December holiday period;
- 1.3. Fields of study:
  - Plant & Soil Science
  - Food Production Systems
  - Agricultural Economics
  - Agricultural Production & Management
- 1.4. First preference will be given to:

Previously disadvantaged individuals which shall include:

- Black/coloured/Indian applicants or persons with disabilities;
- · Applicants with a financial need
- Unemployed Youth (age group 19 25)

## 2. VALUE OF THE BURSARY

- 2.1. The bursary will cover the following costs to the sole discression of Southern Farm (Pty) Ltd:
  - 2.1.1. Registration Fees
  - 2.1.2. Tuition Fees will be paid directly to Stellenbosch University in accordance with their payment regulations
  - 2.1.3. Prescribed Text Books
  - 2.1.4. Accommodation allowance Attach proof of accommodation cost per year (Hostel/Flat/Room)
  - 2.1.5. Any other amount at the discression of the Company
- 2.2. It shall be the successful applicant's responsibility to ensure that the Company is timeously informed of the due dates for payment of all monies and to furnish the Company with all invoices and documents related to the costs involved.

### 3. REPAYMENT OF BURSARIES

3.1. Successful applicants may be expected to remain in the employ of the Company for a period equal to the number of years of the awarded bursary ("work back period"). Such employment is subject to the normal selection criteria and procedures, salary and employment conditions of the Company.

3.2. Should the successful applicant's employment be terminated for any reasons as stipulated in the Basic Terms and Conditions of the Temporary Service Contract, prior to full work back period being completed, the applicant agrees to repay the assistance that was provided equal to the period that is not completed under the work back period.

3.3. Successful applicants will be required to work during June and December holiday periods at the business address or such other farm or address at discression of the Company in the relevant year in which the bursary was awarded.

3.4. Having a bursary, "work back period" or temporary holiday work at the Company, does not guarantee a permanent position at the Company or any of the other farms.

### 4. APPLICATION AND SELECTION

4.1. The application form must be fully and correctly completed and signed by the applicant;

4.2. All documents requested on the application form must be submitted and failure to comply may result in the application being deemed incomplete;

4.3. Any false information supplied, will lead to immediate cancellation of a bursary;

4.4. Applicants will be expected to attend a quarterly progress meeting at the Company's office in Stellenbosch;

4.5. Successful applicants will be informed during December or January;

Bursaries are renewable annually, subject to proof of progress from Stellenbosch University.

 The successful candidate will need to sign a contract specifying the terms and conditions of the bursary.
